Dr. Minuzzi is a psychiatrist at the Mood Disorders Program (St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton, SJHH) and at the Women's Health Concerns Clinic (SJHH). He is also instructor of the MiNDS Neuroscience Graduate Program at McMaster University.

Dr. Minuzzi's research interests include the aspects of brain neurotransmission between hormones and mood disorders, and their clinical implications for treatment and prevention. His projects involve structural brain evaluation (cortical thickness analysis and volumetry of subcortical structures), and functional MRI (BOLD response and MR spectroscopy).
