Research Work

My research focuses on violent behavior and risk assessment. I am interested in understanding the psychobiological background underlying deviant behaviour. I have a particular interest in sexual offenses and online offenses. I believe that the use of technology such as virtual reality can enhance our understanding and treatment of offenders. In terms of sex research, I also developed an interest in studying normal sexual behaviour as a way to understand deviant sexual behaviour. Also, I feel that stigma and media representation of the forensic population are items that require further research to help these individuals to reintegrate into the community. Within the Forensic Program, we launched a new forensic mental health journal, International Journal of Risk and Recovery (IJRR) that addresses articles relevant for clinical practice.
